Give Your Health a Boost With COVID-19 and Flu Vaccines

COVID-19 continues to spread this winter. You can help prevent infections by washing your hands, wearing a mask in crowded areas, and staying home when you are sick. But the best way to protect yourself (and your loved ones) from severe illness is to get a bivalent booster shot.

This additional booster shot includes protection for the Omicron variant of COVID-19. Most adults and children aged six months and older can receive this booster two months after their first vaccine series. Please visit the <u>Centers</u> <u>for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)</u> website for more vaccine guidance.

Experts are still learning how long immunity lasts after a COVID-19 infection. Even if you recently had the virus, you may be eligible to receive a bivalent booster. EmblemHealth will continue to update COVID-19 <u>vaccine information</u> on our website.
